

Safety Rules for Gong Shooters

1. Treat all firearms as if they are loaded.
2. Keep all actions and cylinders open and empty behind the firing line.
3. Move all firearms with the muzzle pointing up or pointing down. Do not sweep the area.
4. Do not load until you are on the firing line and ready to shoot.
5. Keep finger off of the trigger until you are on the target.
6. A safe area will be provided to load Cap' n Ball revolvers.
7. Percussion caps for revolvers and muzzle loaders will only be installed at the firing line.
8. Pay attention to Range Safety Flags.
RED the line is hot.
YELLOW is CAUTION. Someone will be or is down range. Guns will be made safe and there will be no shooting until the yellow flag comes down and the red flag is put back up.
9. If a shooter sweeps the line while shooting or loading or transporting a firearm, bring it to their attention.
10. **SAFETY IS EVERY SHOOTER'S RESPONSIBILITY**
11. **If in doubt, ask!**
